- Submit most recent grade point average
- Submit a brief essay about their interests in business, an innovative business idea or concept they would like to explore and any other information about themselves they would like to share.

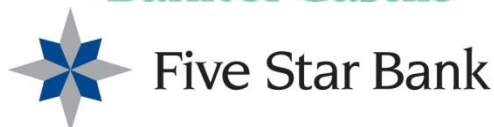
